Greetings!

The commencement of the academic session 2022-23 has seen the corridors of the campus abuzz with excitement and activity characteristic to the dissemination of knowledge. Further to the same, certain measures have been introduced by DOE for the academic session 2022-23.

The following scheme of studies is to be followed in school for the students of classes VI-VIII:

**Periodic Assessment (PA)/Monday test(MT)** - MTs will be conducted as per the schedule given in the almanac. The test will be based on the outlined syllabus for the two terms. The syllabus shall be provided by the subject teachers prior to the scheduled date.

## Internal Assessment

- Multiple Assessment (MA) MA is a part of internal assessment and aims at evaluating the performance of students more comprehensively using multiple and diverse techniques such as oral tests, individual or group work, class discussion, concept maps (Mind maps), graphic organisers (Flow charts, Timelines, diagrams etc.) or any other visual representation.
- Portfolio Assessment (PF) A Portfolio is an extension of notebooks developed subjectwise. The assessment would include classwork and homework assignments that assist in evaluating the students' progress. Besides this, portfolio should be a space for student to display his/her exemplary work in the related area.
- Subject Enrichment Activities (SEA) —The subject specific activities are aimed at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students. These activities will be conducted throughout the year and shall be evaluated at the term end. Activities such as recitation, role-play, declamation, picture reading and debate shall be carried out to develop effective

speaking and listening skills in language. Hands-on activities, Lab work Project work shall be conducted in Mathematics, Science and Social Studies.

Co-Scholastic Activities -For the holistic development of the students, the student shall be graded in Work Education, Visual and Performing Arts, Health and Physical Education. Aspects such as regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork shall be the criteria for grading the co-scholastic activities.

Report Card -The report card shall be issued to the students at the conclusion of each term which will reflect the marks scored by the student for each subject. The final result shall take into account 50% marks secured by student in Term-I and 50% marks secured by student in Term-II. Student securing 80% and above marks in final result shall be eligible for receiving Scholar Badge at the end of the academic session.

## SIGNIFICANT RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Please ensure that your ward wears the **RFID** card every day to school.
- 2. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has framed guidelines for Safe Transportation of school children. Going an extra mile to ensure the safety and security of its students, the school has deputed lady guards in some of the buses. School has started AC buses on all routes (except three buses owned by school). Therefore, the parents, who are still sending their wards by private vans/cabs, are advised to avail the school bus service at the earliest as the Delhi Traffic Police and Transport Departments are taking action at their own end under the Motor Vehicle Act 1988 from time to time against private vans/cabs which are plying illegally.
- 3. Students are **NOT** allowed to bring Mobile phones, I-Pods, Smart watches and Cameras to school. Parents of those students found in possession of any of the above, would be required to submit a fine of Rs. 1000/- to the school.
- 4. Students are **NOT** allowed to bring any sharp edged instrument to school, eg. knife, cutter, blade etc.
- 5. Students are **NOT** allowed to celebrate their birthdays in school.
- 6. Students found using unfair means during any examination, shall be dealt with very strictly leading to immediate cancellation of his/ her paper.
- 7. Kindly ensure that your ward does not have a Facebook, Instagram or any other social networking account as this can be misused for luring youngsters to engage in anti-social activities.
- 8. Kindly check uniform, haircut, nails and punctuality of your ward.
- 9. Kindly attend the PTMs regularly. There are three PTMs in the entire session, the dates of which are already mentioned in the school almanac. You will also receive a message before every PTM. Also, verify the parental data with the class teacher.
- 10. Parents can meet any of the school authorities only after taking prior appointment with the concerned person through the school almanac.
- 11. Frequent reminders are made and checks have been put in place to ensure that all students follow Covid-19 appropriate norms including wearing of a face mask, use of sanitizers and maintaining social distance. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward is fully vaccinated.
- 12. Unwell students will **NOT** be allowed to attend school or take any Test or Examination.
- 13. Students should not bring crackers and colours to the school. Bursting of crackers and playing with colours is liable to lead to expulsion of a student from the School.
