The school has issued new RFID and attendant cards to the students. Parents should ensure that their wards are wearing the RFID cards every day. Some activities organized/ planned by the school during Term I:

English Language Week – The English Department of the junior school organised English Language Week, 'ENGLISH FIESTA' for the students of classes III, IV and V from 27th July, 2022 to 29th July, 2022. Children participated with great zest and zeal in all the activities which were planned for them. An Intra-Class Talent Show activity was organized for the children wherein all the children participated enthusiastically and showcased their creativity magnificently through Story Telling, Enactment, Recitation, etc. In order to instill the love for poetry and enhance the recital skills, an Inter-House Choral Recitation was held for the students of Class IV. In order to enhance the spellings and literary skills of children, an Inter-Section Spell Bee was conducted for the students of Class III and Inter-Section Language Quiz for the students of Class V.

Independence Day Assembly – Students of Class V presented a special assembly to mark our 76th Independence Day on the 13th of August, 2022. The assembly had all the flavours starting with a beautiful patriotic song sung by the junior school choir, followed by a heart touching skit showcasing what freedom means to today's young generation. Students also presented role play wherein they enacted the inspiring words of our freedom fighters and remembered their sacrifice. This was followed by a spectacular dance performance by the students to kindle the patriotic fervour in all. The assembly concluded with our the National Anthem.

Hindi Week – The Hindi Department is celebrating Hindi Language Week for the students of classes III, IV and V in the fourth week of August. A plethora of activities have been planned such as Show and Tell, Slogan Writing, Poem Recitation, Dohawali by different poets and speeches by famous personalities.

Investiture Ceremony –Many rounds of interviews were held to select the deserving students from Class V for the Junior School Council and House Appointees, for the current

academic year. The Investiture Ceremony will be held in the month of September wherein the young leaders shall take an oath to uphold the values and ethos of the school, with utmost sincerity and dedication and commit to work for their fellow students.

Competitive Classes (Mathematics) - Students from classes IV and V were selected on the basis of an entrance test and are being extensively trained for various Inter-School Mathematics Competitions to be held at the end of the academic session 2022-23, namely Aryabhata and Ramanujan Inter-School Mathematics Competitions conducted by Summer Fields School and Modern School respectively. The students of Class IV are given coaching so that they are better equipped to start the training for the competitions when they enroll in Class V. These learners are being trained by the Junior School Mathematics Department, by conducting extra classes, twice a week.

We are concerned that our students carry heavy bags to school which has an adverse effect on their health. To lighten up the student's load and "heavy burden" carried by them, kindly note:

- All Text Books, Workbooks and Lab files are to be kept in the classroom. The books shall be distributed a week prior to the scheduled test or for an assigned homework.
- Students should carry notebooks as per the Time Table.
- Parents are advised to supervise the bag packing on daily basis and send child friendly light bags.

The school hopes for whole hearted cooperation in the future too, in our endeavour to make learning fun for our students. The school would like to take this opportunity to wish the students and the parents all the best for the forthcoming examination.

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
