An insight into the profiles of the young authors:



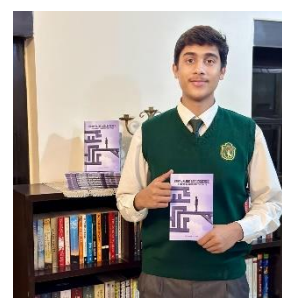
