Dear Parents

**Greetings to you all from the Delhi Public School Vasant Kunj family.**

We are successfully coming to the end of the Ist Term in the month of September. The Ist Term Examination will be conducted from the second week of September. The teachers are ensuring that the syllabus is completed on time and the students acquire an appropriate level of preparation in all the subjects.

The Junior school has successfully adopted the Uniform System of Assessment on Term Assessment basis, as per the new CBSE guidelines . Under the new system of assessment, emphasis will be laid upon the written test.

**We would like you to kindly take note of the Examination Policy for the current academic year:**

**Term I= 20% Internal Assessment + 80% Ist Term Examination**

Internal Assessment=Unit Test (10%)+Notebook Submission(5%)+ Subject Enrichment Activities(5%)

**Term II= 20% Internal Assessment + 80% 2nd Term Examination**

Internal Assessment=Unit Test (10%)+Notebook Submission(5%)+ Subject Enrichment Activities(5%)

**Final Result=Term I(50%)+Term II(50%)**

- **The weightage for the Term End Examination will be 40 marks for Class III and 50 marks for Classes IV and V, respectively.** This change is being incorporated as we want our children to transit gradually from junior to senior classes and be ready to follow their assessment patterns.
- Kindly note that students who are unwell, shall not be allowed to sit for the examination. Replication of marks for the Unit Test and Term End Exam shall be done only on medical grounds, on submission of a medical certificate.
- Emphasis shall be laid on regular notebook submission, written work, maintenance of the notebooks and workbooks by the students. Please ensure that the work of your ward is complete and corrected timely by the teachers.

We want to ensure that our students do not carry heavy bags to school. To lighten the bags' load carried by them, we have formulated a schedule. Kindly note:

- All Textbooks, Workbooks and Lab Files will be kept in the classroom. The books shall be distributed a week prior to the scheduled test or for an assigned homework.
- Students should carry notebooks as per the Timetable.
- Parents are requested to supervise the packing of the school bag on a daily basis and send child- friendly, light-weight bags.
- Homework shall be given uniformly over the week with Mathematics homework to be given thrice a week on alternate days, English homework-twice a week and remaining subjects i.e., Hindi, EVS and Third Language, once a week.

The school organised the following events for the students recently:

- The Junior School organised a weeklong "Patriotic Week" to mark the onset of the 71st year of India's Independence. An array of activities were organized for the students. An Inter-House Patriotic Song Competition was organised for the students of Class V. A Hindi Recitation Competition was held for Class III students. Origami and Kite-Making Workshops were conducted for Classes IV and V. Patriotic movies and documentaries were shown to the students, which infused patriotic fervour. The students of Class V presented an inspiring Independence Day Assembly.
- The Junior School is organizing an Annual Play for Classes IV and V in the month of October, wherein each and every child would be participating. The preparations have already commenced in the right earnest, with the auditions being carried out. It is our sincere effort to provide as many opportunities as possible to our children, in order to showcase and hone their talents.
