Some activities organized/ planned by the school during Term I:

Talent Fiesta – Talent Fiesta was organized for the students of classes III to V from 18th June, 2021 to 5th July, 2021. Children showcased their hidden talent with poise and credence in various activities ranging from a variety of dances and music to elocution, art and craft. This rendered an opportunity to pursue academic excellence and to unravel the creative talent of the young students. Further, the event helped the teachers to identify the interest of each child.

English Week – The English Department of the Junior School celebrated English Language Week for the students of classes III, IV and V from 2nd August, 2021 to 6th August, 2021. The activities conducted were Tell a Tale for Class III, Characters come alive for Class IV and Creative Monologue for Class V. Interesting language games were played on the last day of the week.

Hindi Week – The Hindi Department is celebrating Hindi Language Week for the students of classes III, IV and V in the second week of August. A plethora of activities have been planned like Just a Minute, Recitation and Slogan Writing for Class III. Class IV students will take part in Weaving a Story, Speech and Book Mark Making. Class V students will participate in Extempore, Kabir *Dohe* and Menu Card Making.

Mathematics Week- The Mathematics Department of the Junior School will be celebrating Mathematics Week for the students of classes III, IV and V in the last week of August. A plenitude of activities such as Worli art, Tangram puzzles etc. will be planned to make learning Mathematics fun and interesting.

Independence Day Assembly – Students of Class IV will be presenting a special assembly to mark our 75th Independence Day. The program will include a patriotic song, role play by children where they will enact the inspiring words of our freedom fighters and remember their sacrifice. This will be followed by spectacular dance performances that will kindle the patriotic fervour in all.

Students from classes IV and V are being extensively trained for Inter School Mathematics Competitions held at the end of Class V Session, namely Aryabhata and Ramanujan Inter School Mathematics Competitions conducted by Summer Fields School and Modern School respectively. The students from Class IV are given coaching so that they are better equipped to start the training for the competitions when they enroll in Class V. These children are being trained by the Junior School Mathematics Department, by conducting extra classes, twice a week.
