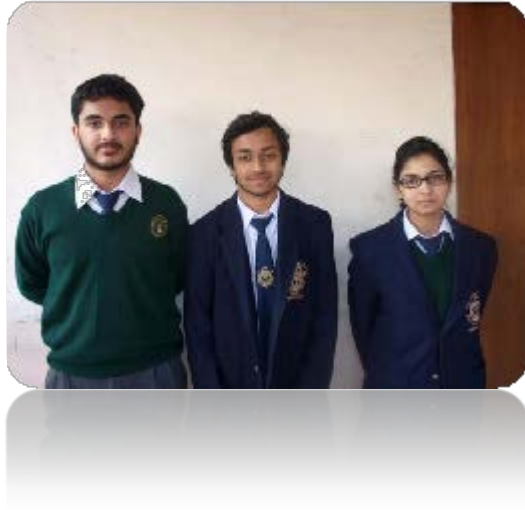

**JEE (Advance)**  
**(For admissions to IIT)**

The selection for this premier institute is a two stage process. On the basis of their performance in the JEE Mains, students were shortlisted for the second phase of selection JEE (Advance).
