Dear Parents

Greetings to you all from the Delhi Public School Vasant Kunj family.

The school is going an extra mile to ensure the safety and security of its students. The school has deputed lady guards in some of the buses for the safety of the students. You are requested to avail the school bus as it is the safest way to commute, for your ward. Please ensure that your ward wears the RFID card to school on a daily basis. However, if you wish to avail your own private vehicles, you must check the antecedents of the driver, vis-a-vis Police Verification Certificate, Licence, Adhaar Card as well as the Permit.

It has been observed that some students bring electronic devices such as smart watches to school. Students are strictly forbidden to bring any electronic item to school and if confiscated, these will not be returned.

We are concerned that our students carry heavy bags to school which has an adverse effect on their health. To lighten the load of the bag, students have been instructed to keep all their Text Books, Workbooks and Lab files in the classroom. The books shall be distributed a week prior to the scheduled test or assigned homework.

- Students should carry notebooks as per the Time Table.
- You are advised to supervise the bag packing on a daily basis and send child friendly, light bags instead of heavy trolley school bags.

The school recently organised the following events for the students:

- 1. Diwali Celebrations :** The junior wing of DPS Vasant Kunj celebrated Diwali in all its grandeur. The week long celebrations commenced from 25th October, 2018. with an Inter-House Rangoli Decoration Competition for Classes IV and V. Students made attractive and colourful rangolis to depict the traditional fervor. Satluj House and Chenab House were jointly declared the winners. Students of Class III took part in the Diya Decoration Competition.
- 2. Children's Day Celebration :** On this joyous occasion, the teachers of the junior school presented a special assembly and entertained the students with various performances to express their care and love for them.

- 3. Annual Day Celebrations - 'Panchtatva':** The students of Classes III, IV and V presented an annual extravaganza 'Panchtatva - The elements of life' in the month of November. The students presented a spectacular performance wherein they depicted the five elements of life through various dance sequences and portrayed how human life flourishes and blossoms in abundance when these five elements co-exist in harmony. The meritorious students of Class IV received Scholar Badges for their academic performance in 2017-18.
- 4. Gurpurab Assembly:** A special assembly on Gurpurab was conducted by the students of Classes III, IV and V to mark the birth anniversary of Guru Nanak Devji. A mesmerizing shabad by the school choir left the audience spell bound. The students shed light on the significance of Gurpurab.
- 5. International Day of Disability:** The junior school celebrated the International Day of Disability in the month of December to sensitize the students to the needs of the differently abled .
