Dear Parents,

Greetings to you all from the Delhi Public School, Vasant Kunj.

The new session has begun with a lot of zest and hope. We recognize that in order to be successful, our children need support from both home and school. A strong partnership between the teachers and parents will make a great difference in your child's growth and learning.

Keeping in mind the safety and security of the students, parents are requested to avail school buses. In case you are not able to, kindly get the documents verified of the drivers/ attendants who will be coming to pick up your ward from the school.

We would like you to take note of the **examination policy** for the current academic session. The students shall be assessed on the entire learning process wherein there is not only emphasis on regular pen and paper tests, but also on the work undertaken throughout the term and the subject enrichment activities.

The examination policy at a glance:

Term I : 20% Internal Assessment + 80% Mid Term Examination

Internal Assessment = Unit Test (10%) + Notebook Submission (5%) + Subject Enrichment Activities(5%)

Term II : 20% Internal Assessment + 80% Final Term Examination

Internal Assessment = Unit Test (10%) + Notebook Submission (5%) + Subject Enrichment Activities(5%)

Final Result = Term I (50%) + Term II (50%)

- **The Term End Examination will be of 40 marks for Class III and 50 marks for Classes IV and V respectively.**
- Emphasis shall be given to regular notebook submission, written work, maintenance of the notebooks and workbooks by the students. Please ensure that the work of your ward is complete and timely submitted for correction to the teachers.
- Computer Science shall be evaluated as a co scholastic subject, marks of which will not be added to the final result. The subject shall be assessed on the basis of practical examination only.

- The teachers are holding after school **remedial classes** for the students who are facing difficulties in academics. This will help to bridge the gaps in learning and to reinforce the concepts taught in school.
- Meritorious students from Class 5 have been selected and are being extensively trained within and after school hours for Inter School Mathematics competitions, namely Aryabhata and Ramanujam. The school is also conducting Aryabhata classes for the students of Class 4 within school hours.

Activities organized by the school in the months of April, May and July:

- **Earth Day** - The EVS Department organized various activities for the students of Classes 3 to 5 to extend support to environment protection on the occasion of Earth Day. Students of 4th standard presented an enthralling special assembly.
- **Computer Day** - The Computer Department organized Computer Day in the month of April wherein the students participated in Intra Class competitions on the topic 'Cyber Safety' and the latest gadgets.
- **Art Day** : To develop the artistic skills amongst the children, the Art Department organized an Art Day in the month of April wherein the students participated in an array of competitions like Best out of the waste, Folk Art and Painting Competitions.
- **Physical Education** : Intersection matches were organized by the Physical Education Department for the Classes 3 to 5 in the month of April and May.
- **Talent Fiesta**: The Junior School organized 'Talent Fiesta' for the students of Classes 3 to 5 to showcase their talent.
- **Language Week** : The Junior School will be celebrating 'Language Week' in the month of July wherein a plethora of fun filled activities will be organized by the English, Hindi and Third Language Departments like Inter Section Enactment on the play 'Malgudi Days', Spell Bee, Inter House Debate, Nukkad Natak, Inter Section reciting of Hymns, Show and Tell, Group Song and Shloka recitation.
- **School Council and House Appointees** : Junior school will be selecting the students of Class V for the school council.

The school hopes for a whole hearted cooperation from the parents in our endeavour to make learning fruitful for the students.
