

# **WORKSHOP - Keep Safe - Be Safe**

**Class : IV**

**Held on 1st December, 2016**

Mrs. Punita Kotiyala, the School Counsellor, organised a workshop on 'Keep Safe - Be Safe' for Classes III-V. The main objective of the workshop was to sensitize children towards the need to protect themselves. The workshop commenced with a discussion on the kinds of dangers for our body and how we can protect ourselves from them in order to stay safe and healthy. Clear distinction between a 'Good Touch' and 'Bad Touch' was explained and discussed through examples and a video. The delicate parts of the body were enlisted and the need for special protection was emphasised. The three main steps of 'NO-GO-RUN' to be taken in a situation of a 'Bad Touch' were emphasised. The concept of 'Safe Circle' was introduced wherein students were encouraged to paste pictures introduced wherein students were encouraged to paste pictures of five adults with whom they could safely share an instance of 'Bad Touch'.
