Now they can Paste or draw picture that begin with the same sound. (4-5 pictures for each sound)


Note for the parents: we will continue to complete the sound book after completion of each sound group after reopening of school too.


ART WITH SHAPES


- •Assist your child to make cut-outs of different shapes and colours.

- •Some examples are given, but you can let your child create his/her own master piece!!





